1. Launching of New Course of One Year Diploma in Computer Teachers Training course(CTTC),approved and recognised by Society for Information Technology Division(SITD),Kerala ,An ISO-9001-2000 Company for Computer & IT Education.
2. The Present strength of students in different courses in all the five institutes are as follows:-
 - a. IGNOU MCA,BCA and CIC : 243
 - b. NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SCTGC,Bariatu : 60
 - c. NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SIIT,Kantatoli : 45
 - d. Computer Teachers Training Course(CTTC),Bariatu : 112
 - e. Computer Teachers Training Course(CTTC) ,Kantatoli : 100
3. Total 1972 Nos. of Computer and Urdu books equivalent to Rs. 1,18,320/- were freely distributed among students of SCTGC and SIIT, in the year 2006-07.
4. Submission of Project Proposal to Maulana Azad Education Foundation(MAEF) for the establishment of New Computer Lab for CTTC course in the above institutes .
5. Founder Chairman visited six Middle East countries from 13th May 2007 – 3rd July 2007 including Kuwait,Bahrain,Abu-Zahbi,Dubai,Sharjah and Ajman.The trip was very successful as several organisation invited Founder Chairman to apprise the NRIs regarding the Educational and Economical status of Indian Muslims specially in the light of Sachar committee report.
6. 8th Convocation of both the computer institutes i.e, SCTGC, Bariatu and SIIT, Kantatoli was organized on 19.08.2007 in which 47 No's of students were awarded Diploma in Computer Application & Multilingual DTP.
7. The Chief Guest of the 8th Convocation was Shree Alamgir Alam, Speaker Jharkhand Assembly, Ranchi. The Guests of Honour were Jb Dr. Neyaz Ahmad, I.P.S., A.D.G.P. Jharkhand, and Mrs. Manju Sinha ,Principal Women's College .The function was presided by Dr. Abdul Subhan, Vice Chairman, Jharkhand Academic Council.
8. Br. Afsar Ali President Urdu Mahaz ,Jamshedpur & Trustee MAS organized a Inter School debate competition on 29th July 2007 in

honour of Founder Chairman. The topic was “Hindustan Ki Jaddo-Jehad Azadi Mein Urdu Ka Hissa”, in which more than 10 Urdu Medium Schools participated. The award was given by the Trust to the students.

9. 2 Co-ordinators and 2 New instructors were appointed for running the CTTC course at both the centers. With this the present strength of regular staff is 15 and the No. of part time counselors is 20 in the Trust.
10. 800 Kg of food grains were distributed among “Below Poverty Line” people of Kamta village, Khizirtola village, Sattar Colony”, “Morabadi” and “Kishunpur locality in Ranchi district during 03/10/07 to 08/10/07.
