Year 2008- 2009

- 1. Activation of MBA Course by IGNOU vide its Notification No. IG/RSD/Notification dated 18.06.08.
- 2. The enrollment of students in different courses in all the five institutes was as follows:
 - a. IGNOU MCA, BCA and CIC: 243
 - b. NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SCTGC, Bariatu : 26
 - c. NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SIIT, Kantatoli : 46
 - d. Computer Teachers Training Course(CTTC), Bariatu : 73
 - e. Computer Teachers Training Course(CTTC), Kantatoli : 153
- 3. Trust organised a Seminar on "Non-Violence Peace and Spirituality - Principle and Practices in Different Religions" on 10th April 2008 in collaboration with Interfaith Coalition for Peace,New Delhi. The Chief Guest of the function was Hono'ble Governor of Jharkhand Syed Sibtey Razi and the it was presided by Janab Zafar Mahmood ,OSD ,Prime Minister High Level Sachar Committee.
- 4. ^{9th} Convocation of both the computer institutes i,e, SCTGC, Bariatu and SIIT, Kantatoli was organized on 24th May 2008 in which 51 No's of students were awarded Diploma in Computer Application & Multilingual DTP.
- 5. The Chief Guest of the 9th Convocation was His Excellency Jb. Syed Sibtey Razi Sb. The Guests of Honour were Jb. Basir Ahmad Khan, Pro-Vice Chancellor of IGNOU, Jb. A.A.Khan, Vice-Chancellor of Ranchi University, Ranchi, Smt. Sarah Nasreen, RD of MANUU and Dr. M.P. Mahendra Singh, Vice-Chanellor of Vinoba Bhawey University, Hazaribagh.
- 6. The topic of Seminar was "Empowering Disadvantaged ,Minorities and Marginalised Groups through Open Distance Learning System – With Special Reference to Sachar Committee Report, IGNOU and MANUU Initiatives" was also organized by the Trust. The Seminar was presided by Jb. Basir Ahmad Khan, Pro-Vice Chancellor, IGNOU, New Delhi.

- 7. Trust hired three new premises (1200 Sq.ft.)at Kantatoli Chowk with the monthly rent of Rs. 10,000/- for organizing Computer Teachers Training course of SITD and MBA course of IGNOU.
- 8. Dr. Qazi Ashfaq Ahmad ,Sydney ,Australia visited Trust in his special "Mission India Tour" from 5th Nov. 2008 to 11th Nov. 2008 and decided to stay 6 months from July 2009 to Feb.2010 in Ranchi and work jointly with the Trust.
- 9. Total 1540 Nos. of Computer and Urdu books equivalent to Rs. 92,400/- were freely distributed among students of SCTGC and SIIT, in the year 2008-09.
- 10. Br. Afsar Ali President Urdu Mahaz ,Jamshedpur organized a Inter School debate competition among girls on 26th Oct. 2008 in honour of Founder Chairman. The topic was "Larkiuon Ka Qeemati Zevar - Taleem", in which more than 10 Urdu Medium Schools participated. The award was given by the chairperson & Treasurer of the Trust to the students.
- 11. 800 Kg of food grains of Rs. 40,000/- were distributed among "Below Poverty Line" people of Nawasarai, Neori ,Barway villages ,Khizirtola village,Sattar Colony" ,"Morabadi" and "Kishunpur locality in Ranchi district during 04/10/08 to 12/10/08.
- 12. Trust distributed 47 Nos. of scholarship among needy and financial weak students of worth Rs. 86,316/- for both the centers. Trust also awarded Special Merit scholarship of Rs. 8,400/- to three IGNOU students in MCA & BCA for clearing all the papers in first attempt .
- 13. The Inspection of MAEF Project for the Expansion of computer lab was carried on 14th & 15th Feb. 2009.Mr. Alauddin ,Retd. Deputy Secretary,Bihar Govt. was nominated by MAEF for the inspection.
- 14. Trust applied for the activation of the Study Centre from Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) for the courses of Diploma in Journalism & Mass communication, Diploma in Teach English,Functional English ,M.A History,English & Urdu and B.A.
- 15. Trust purchased 10 Nos. of new machines of make "Lenovo" and established its 4th computer lab .Thus Trust is now having 50 No's of computers all together for above institutes.
- 16. The result of 1st batch of Computer Teachers Training course was declared on 15th March 2009 in which 39 No's of students received one year Diplome in CTTC course. All students got first class.
