

# **ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT OF THE TRUST**

**Year – 2010-2011**

1. The Present strength of students in different courses in all the four institutes are as follows:-
  - i) IGNOU MBA ,MCA,BCA and CIT : 346
  - ii) NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SCTGC, Bariatu: 33
  - iii) NCPUL One Year DCA/DTP Course at SIIT, Kantatoli : 90
  - iv) Computer Teachers Training Course(CTTC),Bariatu& Kantatoli: 41
  - v) Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) : 200
2. Trust conducted the “Rahmani 30” test on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2010 for Class 10<sup>th</sup> students in the same pattern of “Super 30” for IIT-JEE Examinations.
3. A meeting was held with the convenor of Eastern Panel IDB Jb. Dr. Ahmad Abdul Hai in his residence at Patna on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2010 in which the IDB School project & IDB Special Coaching scheme were discussed. Both founder chairman and secretary Trust were present in the meeting along with Jb. Shafi Mashhadi, former Member JPSC & Dr. Imteyaz Ahmad, Director Khuda Baksh Khan Library.
4. A proposal for IDB special Coaching Programme was prepared by the Trust with the collaboration of “The Ambition ,Ranchi” and submitted to IDB on 06/10/2010.
5. A fresh proposal for IDB School project was prepared and two copies were submitted to Dr. Ahmad Abdul Hai, Convenor IDB Eastern Panel and one copy was submitted to Dr. Majid Alam, Member IDB Eastern Panel Jharkhand for their kind perusal.
6. Trust organised the Islamic Development Bank (IDB) Scholarship Pre-Selection Seminar & Interview (PSI) with the collaboration of Muslim Education Trust (MET),New Delhi for Jharkhand candidates on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2010. 22 students appeared in one day PSI and out of these 7 candidates were finally selected for IDB Scholarship 2010-11 session.
7. 11<sup>th</sup> Convocation of both the computer institutes i,e, SCTGC, Bariatu and SIIT, Kantatoli was organized on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2010 at SDC Hall ,Purulia road in which 92 Nos. of students of CTTC, 8 nos.-CPAC & 60 nos. of students for DCA-DTP courses were awarded Diploma.
8. The Chief Guest of the 11<sup>th</sup> Convocation was Shree Devashish Gupta, IAS, Chief Electoral Officer, Jharkhand and the function was presided over by Shree C.S.Jha ,Former CMD ,ECL. Janab Sayeed Ahmad Ansari, Director Project ,Apollo Hospital Irba, Shree Prof. B.Prasad, former Dean Faculty of Commerce ,RU and Shree Sunny C.C., Regional Director ,SITD ,Bihar & Jharkhand were also present in the function as Guest of Honour.
9. Total 1302 Nos. of Computer books and Urdu books equivalent to Rs.78120 were freely distributed among students of SCTGC and SIIT, in the year 2010.

Trust distributed 37 Nos. of scholarship among needy and financially weak students of worth Rs.42,174=00 for MCA,BCA, & DCA/DTP courses for the students of both the centers in the year 2010. 6 Nos. of our students also got the Ministry of Minority Affairs Merit cum Means Scholarship of amount Rs. 86,975.
11. Secretary Trust attended the Workshop on “Promoting Good Governance in CSOs” from 12-13<sup>th</sup> July 2010 at Kolkata. The Programme was organized by VANI, New Delhi and Mass Education, Kolkata.
12. Trust purchased 51 decimal of land at Piska-Nagri for expansion and future plans of the Trust on 28/10/2010.
